

BACKGROUND

In January 2020, East Suffolk Council established a Lowestoft Place Board to oversee the development of a Town Investment Plan, to strategically move forward work on the regeneration of Lowestoft. The Lowestoft Place Board is made up of representatives from a range of public, private, and voluntary sector organisations who are working together to maximise opportunities to improve and promote Lowestoft. The Board also provides support to officers and partners responsible for delivery.

STEPHEN JAVES – CHAIR, LOWESTOFT PLACE BOARD

In 2018, Stephen retired as the CEO of Orwell Housing Group after 27 years, where he had led the Group from a turnover of £750,000pa, to £70m. In addition to housing services, Orwell developed a successful care division providing care and support for the elderly, young people, and those with learning difficulties. The group provided development services to a significant group of clients throughout the region, and a separate company was created to build housing for sale. In 2007, Stephen was responsible for the creation of Eastern Procurement Limited which specialises in providing procurement services for other organisations where large maintenance contracts need to be put in place and was Chair of the Board for the initial 3 years of trading.

Since retirement Stephen provides business advice and coaching to local companies in law, finance, and building contracting as well as being a Board Member of the James Paget University Hospital, and Chair of the Lowestoft Place Board.
