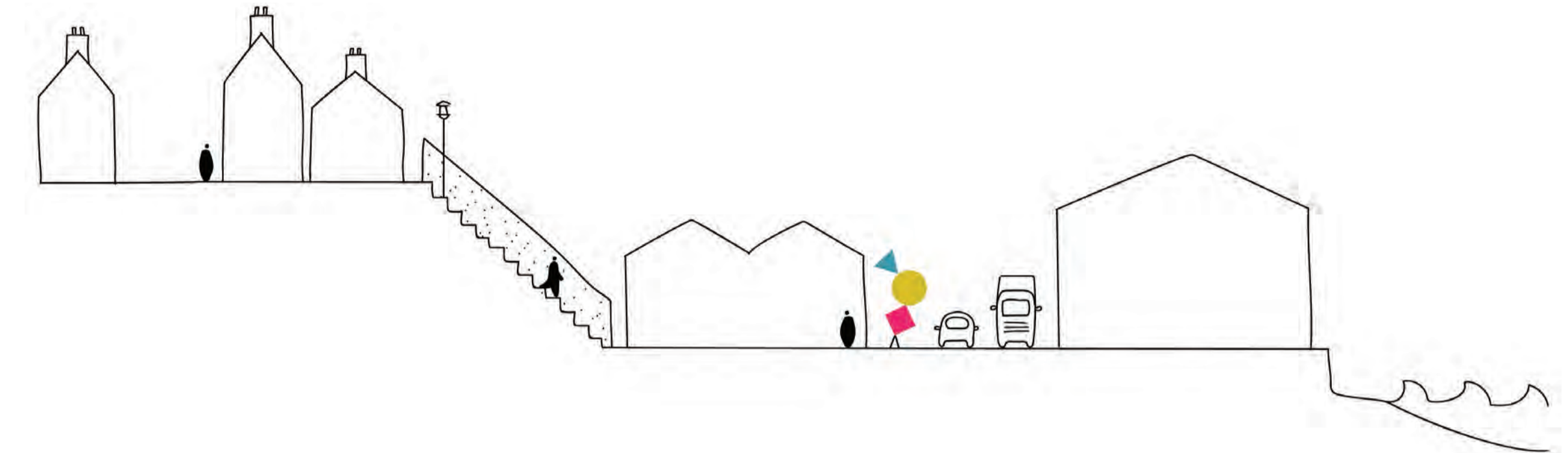


5 - Strengthening the Scores Experience

Aims

- Redefine the Scores as a cultural destination by delivering more art works and creating the **Lowestoft Scores Sculpture Trail** which will interweave with the existing Red Herring Trail.
- Inject green spaces through the use of rain gardens and a new **Scores Gateway Garden**.
- Celebrate the quirky historic elements that already exist by replacing lost and damaged **interpretation signage**.
- Improve accessibility by resurfacing broken paving and creating **pedestrian priority crossings** along Whapload Road.



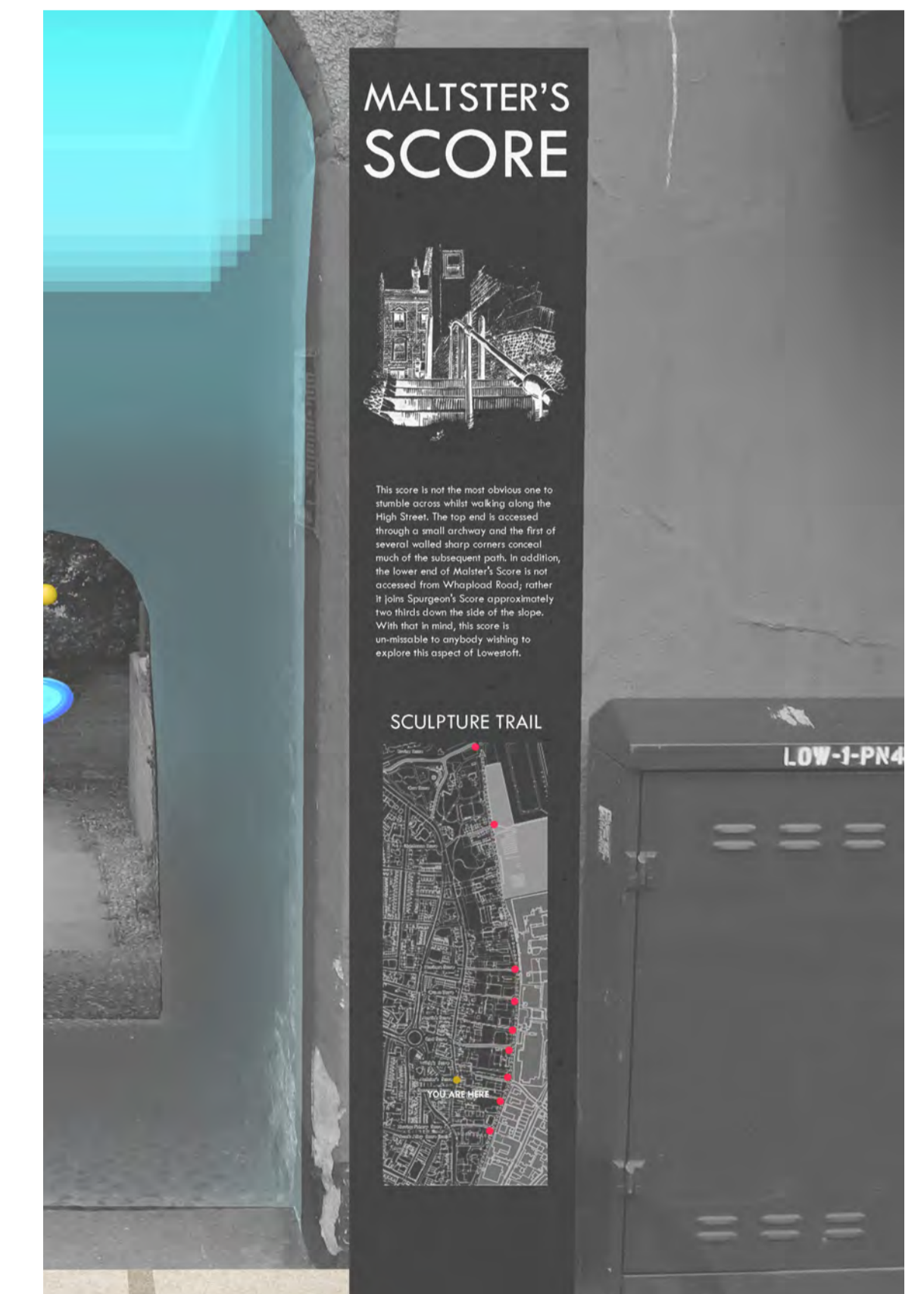

The Scores Sculpture Trail

The creation of the Lowestoft Scores Sculpture Trail will see the commission and installation of 15 sculptures. The sculpture trail will be enhanced by the creation of a gateway garden which will sit just south of the most southerly Score, Herring Fishery Score.

Signage

Free-standing interpretation panels will mark the entrance to each Score at the High Street end. They will be made out of weather-resistant metal and will capture the existing information on the individual Scores in an accessible typography and font size. They will be illuminated to improve access at night and to highlight the Scores entrance.
